Ypsilanti Meals on Wheels (YMOW) is seeking an experienced Social Worker to improve the in-home safety of older adults and medically fragile adults who reside within the YMOW service area, helping them to continue living safely and comfortably at home.

Position Summary:

The Social Worker empowers older adults and medically fragile adults with complex needs to:

- Build competencies to claim a leadership role within their healthcare team.
- Adjust to and prepare for evolving chronic care needs.
- Identify resources to help meet their unmet needs.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Conduct assessments to determine psychosocial-emotional status, healthcare status, and to identify unmet needs.
- Compile, record and code client assessments in ServTracker system.
- Manage assessments, including keeping track of when assessments are due, assigning students to complete assessments, and reviewing student assessments for accuracy.
- Use case management skills to help homebound clients fill unmet needs.
- Supervise YMOW student interns, including weekly supervision for social work interns.
- Maintain positive, effective communication skills in all interactions.
- Act as a liaison between clinical team, clients, and students.
- Adhere to YMOW organizational policies and procedures, including HIPAA standards.
- Maintain active and current registration and/or licensure via LARA.
- Assist YMOW with grant writing.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Social Work degree from an accredited program and valid Michigan LBSW license required (minimum). Masters in Social work and valid Michigan LLMSW license preferred.
- Extensive knowledge and expertise of the continuum of care for older adults required.
- Minimum 2 years social work experience in a healthcare or community setting required, with
 preferred work experience with older adults.
- Minimum of 3 years case management and benefits counseling experience required & 10+ years for LBSW candidates.
- Experience assisting clients with benefit applications for Medicaid & state assistance programs required, with MI-Bridges system experience preferred.
- Certification as a Michigan Medicare Medicaid Assistance Program (MMMAP) Counselor or willingness to achieve certification within 6 months.
- Ability to work with a collaborative team, strong attention to detail, and good communication skills.
- Reliable transportation with valid driver's license in good standing.
- Must be comfortable working with diverse clients in their homes (remote currently due to the pandemic).
- Familiarity with Washtenaw County resources.
- Ability to work remotely and participate in Zoom meetings.
- Ability to work the occasional holiday and Saturdays when needed.
